A SEPARATE APPLICATION FORM IS TO BE SUBMITTED FOR EACH VEHICLE TO BE ENTERED IN THE CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE. INCOMPLETE APPLICATION FORMS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. ENTRY FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE UNLESS WITHDRAWAL IS ADVISED UP TO FIFTEEN (15) DAYS BEFORE THE EVENT. NO-SHOWS ARE LIKEWISE NOT REFUNDABLE.

Vehicles with the greatest number of points in each class will qualify to compete for the **Best in Show Award**. All cars whatever the category, may compete for the **Best Historic Award** and **Best Restoration Award** (the latter excluding Preservation (Original) Class, and other various/relevant Awards as listed on pg 4.

All vehicles will automatically be included to participate for other sponsor awards, adjudicated solely at the discretion of the event **Sponsors**. These awards are the **Enemed Award, FimBank Award, LESA Award, VBL Award** and **PMF Award**, etc.

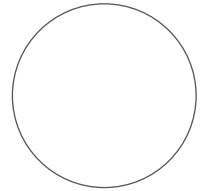

RULES REGARDING THE DISPLAY OF VEHICLE

- Cars to arrive at concours venue by **7.30am**.
- Make sure to adhere to **VERY SLOW SPEED** limit.
- **Disconnect Battery** when parked and fix participating car number provided by the Stewards to vehicle. Also ask about the whereabouts of the closest fire fighting equipment.
- It is the **Owners' Responsibility** to ensure their vehicle is parked in such a way, and that any precautionary measures are in place, so that the vehicle cannot roll forward or backward.
- **Cars with oil leaks** must ask stewards for a preventive undermat **to be placed under the engine compartment**, as soon as the car is parked in its designated position.
- Once the vehicle is parked in its display position the driver is requested **not to move** the vehicle until the end of the Award presentation ceremony, unless they have the permission of the event Organiser and support of a designated event Steward. Non Adherence to this, entrant maybe banned from participating in future events.
- **Keys** should never be left in the ignition and if vehicle is left unattended even for a short period of time, the doors must be locked.
- **Period Style Clothing is encouraged to be worn during the event.** This can add value to the presentation of the car. Register at the site office on the day of the concours.
- **No Umbrellas etc. can be set up near the vehicles.**
- **No Advertising is allowed unless approved by the Organisers.**
- **Smoking** is prohibited closer than **Two Metres** to the vehicles, and **filling of fuel tanks is strictly prohibited**. It is advised that vehicle owners provide their own in date fire extinguisher.
- The **running of engines is prohibited** unless instructed by the Judging Team or the Organisers.
- Exhibitors are expected to keep the area (including paving) around the exhibits clean and clear from other belongings.
- **Exit from St George's Square, shall commence after the award presentation ceremony. This is to be done in an orderly manner as directed by the organisers at the end of the event. Non compliance to this clause, entrants will be held liable for any damages/ injuries to third parties.**
- **Exhibitors are expected to comply with all reasonable instructions provided by the Event Staff.**

The Organisers expect that every participant is aware of the relevant safety regulations and Rules appertaining to the event and should the participant be in breach of any of the above, accepts that will be immediately disqualified.
